## **REVIVAL:**

### **I. Opening:**

- A. Read definition of revival.
  - 1. *Revival is the extraordinary movement of the Holy Spirit in the hearts of Christians producing extraordinary results.*
- B. A Time to Share:
  - 1. Invite individuals to share where revival is happening in their lives. Focus on the “extraordinary” things is God doing.

### **II. What do You Think?**

- A. Revival.
  - 1. Two weeks ago, Pastor Jamie preached a message from 2 Timothy 1:6-7. In the message he referred to the “unrevived” as those whose full flame had waned to a flicker.
    - a) What can cause a believer’s fire to wane?
    - b) See Ephesians 4:30 and be sure to note its context.
  - 2. Read 2 Timothy 1:6-7 and discuss the three words Paul uses to describe the full-flame believer.
    - a) *Power, love and a sound mind.*
    - b) Discuss the practicality of these three characteristics.

### **III. Hosea 10:12**

- A. Discuss.
  - 1. What is the law of sowing and reaping noted in this verse?
  - 2. What do you think it means to break up the “*unplowed ground of our hearts?*”
  - 3. Have you ever had a hard heart that God softened? Explain.

### **IV. Application:**

- A. Questions.
  - 1. How can a believer, on a day-to-day basis, break up “*unplowed ground?*”
  - 2. How is “*seeking the Lord*” related to this goal?

### **V. Closing:**

- A. Share and Prayer.
  - 1. Share personal needs and close with prayer.
